The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board being present.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of February 20, 1970.

Comm. Order #112 and #113 Commissioners Cancellation Orders #712 & #713 were approved by the Board and signed by the Chairman. Orders are on file in the office of the County Clerk.

The Board approved the payroll for the month of February. See proof of publication on file in the office of the County Clerk.

Beer License

The Board passed a resolution granting a license to sell Cereal Malt Beverage to Derald E. Haas, Ray's Truck Stop, Route #3, Lawrence, Kansas; Grant Township.

Temporary easement granted to Santa Fe Railroad

The Board authorized the Chairman to execute an agreement with the Atchison, Topeka, & Santa Fe Railway Company extending the temporary construction easement with the said railway for a period of 24 months from April 10, 1970, under the same terms and conditions as contained in the original easement. Extension was necessitated to allow the contractor constructing the new bridge across the Kansas River near Lecompton, Kansas, to continue to operate over the Santa Fe right of way during the final construction of the bridge.

Public Hearing Highway #10

The Board received notice from Mr. John Montgomery, Director of Highways of the State of Kansas, informing the Board of a public hearing to be held in Eudora on March 31, 1970, at 1:30 p.m. Purpose of the hearing is to consider the economic, social, and environmental effects of the proposed location of K-10 highway from near Lawrence east to Desota.

Planning & Webster Hill application denied

The Board held a hearing concerning the Planning Board minutes of February 18, 1970. Olin Petefish, Attorney for the Developers' Virgil Holderedge, Project Engineer; Bill Webster, Allan Hill, Developers; Dean Ellermeir, Advisor; Ron Short, Planner; and John Clyatt, County Zoning Administrator, were present. It was moved by Mr. Heck that the Board accept the recommendation of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission to deny the application. The motion was seconded by Mr. Ice and carried unanimously.

Employ Hays Bros. for Auction

The Board received a written proposal from the firm of Hays Brothers Auction Service, setting forth the terms and conditions under which they would conduct the sale of the real estate which is advertized for sale, March 11, 1970. After finding the proposal in accordance with the verbal proposal made to the Board, it was moved by Mr. Heck and seconded by Mr. Ice that the terms and conditions be accepted and Hays Brothers Auction Service be so advised. Motion carried unanimously.

Condemnation Court Case

The Board received a communication from Mr. Gerald L. Cooley, representing the Board in condemnation proceedings, with an attached copy of the ruling of a motion to dismiss. The ruling advised that the appeals were filed in time and that the two cases, Percival vs. The Board of County Commissioners, 25646; and Michael, et. al. vs. The Board of County Commissioners, 25647; will be heard.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on February 27, 1970.
