Board acknowledged receipt of the rent check from Mrs. Edith Hyre, for the property at 1145 Rhode Island, for the month of September.

Hills Sub -

The Board received the minutes of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission meeting held Sept. 23, 1970. Considered was Item #4 of the minutes, a preliminary plat of Cedar-wood Hills subdivision, the NE¹/₄ of the NE¹/₄ and the East 60 acres of the South $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE¹/₄ of Sec. 32-T13-R20, Douglas County, Kansas.

Hills Sub-The Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission recommended approval of the preliminary plat division plut and further recommended that the County Commission move for the adoption of County Subdivision regulations as quickly as possible, and that the developers of the subdivision develop a sewer system for the area which would be more suitable to the area soils than the proposed septic system.

> After consideration of the minutes and review of the proposed preliminary plat, it was moved by Mr. Heck that the Board accept the preliminary plat of Cedarwood Hills subdivision subject to developers of same presenting plans of an approved water supply and sewage disposal accept able to the Lawrence-Douglas County Health Department and the Board of County Commissioners. Seconded by Mr. Ice and carried unanimously.

Planning: Final plat Pine-ne-wa accepted

The Board then considered Item #11 of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission minute of Sept. 23, 1970, the final plat of Pine-ne-wa subdivision, the same being an approximate 150.8 acre tract located in the SW¹₄ of Sec. 19-12-19 Douglas County, Kansas. The Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Commission recommended approval of the final plat subject to the drawing of utility easements on the plat before filing.

After consideration of the recommendations of the Planning Commission and study of the plat in question, it was moved by Mr. Ice that the plat be accepted for filing as soon as all utility easements have been recorded to the satisfaction of the Lawrence-Douglas County Planning Director. Seconded by Mr. Heck and carried unanimously.

Mr. Heck moved that because of anticipated adoption of Douglas County subdivision regulation in the very near future, the Board of County Commissioners will not receive any proposed preliminary subdivision plats prior to Jan. 1, 1971. Seconded by Mr. Ice and carried unanimously. The Board discussed with the County Zoning Administrator the present policy of issuance of building permits in subdivisions. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Ice that the County

Zoning Administrator be instructed to issue no building permits for construction of improve ments in subdivisions or portion thereof, until the area where the improvements are to be constructed is properly served by improved utilities, roadways, and/or improvements as set forth in the approved subdivision plat, and such improved utilities, roadways, and/or im-provements are approved by the Board of County Commissioners. Seconded by Mr. Heck and carried unanimously.

Board acknowledged receipt of the Fund Balances on hand by the County Treasurer as of August 31, 1970.

Juvenile: It was moved by Mr. Heck that the minutes of Sept. 25, 1970, covering the purchase of furni-ture for the Juvenile Courtroom, be corrected to read a total cost of \$707.41, the previous furner in furniture total in error due to improper extensions. Seconded by Mr. Ice and carried unanimously. Sept. 25, 70

The Board received two bids for an electric typewriter for use in the Sheriff's office. The Board approved the purchase of a Model 970 Royal electric typewriter with a 16" carriage, from Lawrence Typewriter in an amount of \$463.50.
