Second item, application for conditional use permit for the construction of a Nursing Home for ditional use located in the East half of the NW4 of 14-13-19, Douglas County, Kansas, to be known as cherry Manor Nursing Home. The final plat of Cherry Manor Subdivision was considered by the Board also. No action was taken on either the conditional use permit or approval of the fin Jubdivision plat, pending clarification of dedication of the utility easements on the final plat and an agreement pertaining to access on the conditional use permit 1 agreement pertaining to access on the conditional use permit.

So. of the Northwest corner of 23-12-19, and running 420 ft. So. on the West boundary of Sec. 23. Application was approved by the County Engineer. It was moved by Mr. Ice and seconded by Mr. Heck that the application be approved. Motion carried unanimously.

Board received a letter of request from Dr. Harold Pippin, requesting consideration be given to a proposed application for a permit for an advertising sign at his new residence on Rt. West of Lawrence. The matter was taken under advisement by the Board until Friday, Nov. 6th

Bids: Thinting The Board received 2 bids for printing supplies for the Co. Assessor's office from Meseraull supplies for printing Co. and Allen Press. It was moved by Mr. Ice that the Assessor be authorized to purchase 15,000 $8\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 card forms from the low bidder, Allen Press, in the amount of \$165.1 diseasers GC. Seconded by Mr. Glass and carried unanimously.

The Board acknowledged receipt of a statement of Community Junior College Out-District Tuition from Johnson County Community Junior College, Shawnee Mission, Kansas, in the amount of \$1,246.10. Statement was referred to the County Clerk for proper handling.
