It was moved by Mr. Ice, seconded by Mr. Cragan that we authorize County Engineer Rice to execute a contract with Concrete Materials Co., Inc. for the crushing and stockpiling at the Walter's Quarry of approximately 15,000 tons of road rock at their bid price of \$1.40 per ton. Motion carried unanimously. It was also agreed that this Board should see that the Kanwaka Twp. Board is so advised in the event their Twp. might also be in need of material at this time.
