Poindexter, to be used at Oak Lodge, Rt. 1, Bald win, Kansas; Gerald Love, to be used at Ray's Truck Stop, Rt. 3, Lawrence, Kansas; to Rita Scott, to be used at Don's Steak House, Rt. 5, Lawrence, Kansas; to James L. Wisler, to be used at Mont Bleu Ski, Inc., Rt. 2, Lawrence, Kansas.

Engr. Rice appeared before the Board to discuss the items of the Mud Creek Levee project which Douglas County would be responsible for. After due discussion, it was agreed that the

County would be responsible for: a. Compaction of the additional fill required for the relocated roads, which fill would be over and above that required for the levee originally. These relocated roads would be between stations 28 and 70: 125 and 139: 212 and 218 between stations 28 and 70; 125 and 139; 212 and 218. b. Clearing and grubbing beneath roadway fills at the above locations.

c. Ramp and drainage pipe at entrance to Highway 24-40 d. Twenty foot extensions of RCP drainage structures through the levee and roadway at

stations 65+00, 131+50, and 216+75.

e. The erosion control structure in the West ditch of the North approach to Bridge MC-2. f. Miscellaneous shallow drainage ditch excavation in conjunction with the relocated roads between Bridges MC-1 and MC-2.
