The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

The Board noted receipt of the April 14 minutes of the Douglas County USDA

Keur-Douglas & Dourd noted receipt of the minutes of the Lawrence-Douglas County Board of Whatth Comm. minute Health Committee meeting of April 10, 1972.

The Board noted receipt and approval of the following monthly reports of fees collected and remitted to the Douglas County Treasurer Office: County Clerk, Register of Deeds, County Court, Road and Bridge Department, Office of the Clerk of the District Court, and Sheriff Department.

The Board further discussed the matter of interpreting recent regulations which may or may not require counties to come under the Federal Unemployment Law. The Board especially noted a communication from Frank Bradley, C.P.A. of our auditing firm Lesh, Bradley, Barrand, and Schehrer, to the effect that it has been determined that counties, cities, and unified school districts can elect not to come under the new law if they so wish. With this information it was moved by Mr. Ice and seconded by Mr. Cragan that we elect not to come under the Federal Unemployment Law, and correspondingly that the green depository cards may be ignored. Motion carried unanimously.

The Board further discussed the matter of the appointment of a committee to make a study of the correctional facility needs in Douglas County. This discussion follows requests from several persons of the community interested in seeing such a study made. It was moved by Mr. Ice and seconded by Mr. Cragan that this Board appoint Dr. Forrest Swall, Assistant Dean of Social Welfare Department, University of Kansas, as Chairman of such a committee and will take the responsibility of securing individuals to serve on such a committee and in turn refer these names to Dr. Swall with a request to him, that he implement the organization of the committee and further that the recommendations which may result from the study of this committee be reported directly to this Board. Motion carried unanimously.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meat on Monday, April 17, 1972.
