Following due discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that Resolution No. 72-29 be hereby adopted, seconded by Mr. Ice, and carried unanimously.

This resolution relates to the providing of minimum construction standards for local roads and streets and other public improvements in subdivisions, other than commercial and industrial developments, herein referred to as residential subdivision, in Douglas County, Kansas.
