County officers and department heads will continue to purchase expendible supplies and items with a value of less than \$100 for use in their offices. The Board recommends that in all possible instances that these purchases be on a basis determined by the individual officer or department head to be competitive and impartial, and that such policy be set out in a memo to all county officers and depart-Commo memo ment heads.
