1. The South Half of the Northwest Fractional Quarter of Section 2, Township 15, Range 19, in Douglas County, Kansas. (Owner - heirs of Carl B. Butell - Leona C. Butell, Carl A. Butell, Martha B. Tonkan (Kalb), Joan B. Hambrick: purchasers under contract - Orvil Fisher and Grace Fisher).
2. The North Half of the Northwest Fractional Quarter of Section 2, Township 15, Range 19, in Douglas County, Kansas; less 2-1/2 acre cemetery by Deed Book Y, page 26; Less .32 acre to State of Kansas by Deed Book 130, page 393; Less 1/2 acre by Deed Book 160, page 159; less .81 acre by Deed Book 165, page 333; Less 1.09 acres by Deed Book 209, page 391 (Owner Cecil F.
