It was moved by Mr. Heck that the Board approve the purchase of this air conditioner, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.

Sheriff Johnson appeared before the Board to request that Jeffrey Miller, radio dispatcher, be reclassified as a part-time permanent employee, as a relief dispatcher, effective September 1, 1973, at a wage rate of \$2.20 per hour. It was moved by Mr. Heck that this request be approved, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Stoneback moved that the Board adjourn and convene at 3:00 p.m. in order that the Board may attend the funeral of Tommy Constant. Motion was seconded by Mr. Heck and carried unanimously.

Mr. Stoneback moved that the County Commission submit to the eligible voters of Douglas County sometime before November 1, 1973, a special election on the following question: Are you in favor of a 1/2¢ county sales tax? (This will replace the 1/2¢ City of Lawrence tax now being collected). The County portion of this tax revenue is to be used for improvement of roads, bridges, and the hiring of additional law enforcement officers due to the creation of the Clinton Reservoir and Park. Motion died for lack of a second.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Wednesday, September 26, 1973.
