Dean Sanderson, Public Works Director, presented the Board prepared Resolution No. 73-31 amending Resolution No. 72-43 which adopted an Organization Plan for the County Public Works Department. It has been determined there is a need for an additional position in the Division of Highway Operations, namely that of Equipment Maintenance Supervisor as depicted by attached Exhibit B to the resolution, labeled "Organization Chart, Douglas County Public Works Department Lawrence, Kansas." The effective date is October 1, 1973, hereinafter called the Revised Organization Plan. It was moved by Mr. Heck that Resolution No. 73-31 be adopted, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.
