The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of November 26, 1973.

The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 1157 and 1158. Orders are on file in the office of the County Clerk.

The Board noted receipt of a boiler control report from the Treanor Company. A copy of the report was given to Mr. Skeet for his records.

The Board considered prices and quotations which they had obtained relative to the purchase of tables and chairs for use at the 4-H Fairgrounds. Following due discussion it was moved by Mr. Heck that the Board accept the proposal of the Monroe Company, Colfax, Iowa, to furnish twenty-four, Model No. CC-308P, 30" x 96" plastic, custom tables, tan linen/beige frame and legs, identical to those purchased in December 1972, at a delivered cost of \$35.75 each, and that we also accept the proposal of the Monroe Company to supply two-hundred, Model No. 1000, polypropylene stacking chairs, red/chrome legs, at \$11.50 per chair, delivered Lawrence, also identical to those chairs purchased from the Monroe Company in December 1972. Motion was seconded by Mr. Stoneback and carried unanimously.

The Board noted receipt of the December rent payment on the property at 1145 Rhode Island in the amount of \$70.

The Board noted receipt of a letter from the Dover Elevator Company stating that they had conducted a safety test on the elevator located in the Valley-view Rest Home. This test was made on November 6, 1973, and indicates a successful performance of the safety devices. The letter was signed by Gene Coulter, Service Supervisor.

The Board received an application for a retail cereal malt beverage license for use at the Lawrence Raquet Club, Route 4, Lawrence, Kansas. The applicant is John W. Sample III. The application was signed and remitted to the Wakarusa Township Board for their consideration.

The Board gave consideration to contracting for diesel fuel supply for the Public Works Department for December 1973 and all of 1974. It was moved by Mr. Heck that we notify by certified letter all recent bidders of Douglas County diesel fuel requirements that we will receive for opening at 10:00 a.m., December 6, 1973, quotations for Douglas County diesel fuel requirements for December 1973 and all of 1974. Motion was seconded by Mr. Stoneback and carried unanimously. A copy of the request of bid will be on file in the office of the Public Works Department.

The Board met with Mr. & Mrs. Bill Vantuyl, developers of Cedarwood Hills Subdivision, and Donald Hamlet and C. V. Williams, Wakarusa Township Board members. It was decided that Mr. & Mrs. Vantuyl should meet with the Wakarusa Township Board on December 8, 1973, to determine the status of the road in Cedarwood Hills Subdivision.
