Dean Sanderson, Public Works Director, appeared before the Board with prepared Resolution No. 74-51 which resolution relates to the transfer of an amount of \$240,000 from the Road and Bridge fund to a Special Highway Improvement Fund as provided in K.S.A. 68-590. Delbert Mathia, County Clerk, appeared before the Board with a quotation from Strong's Office Systems for a Royal electric typewriter, Model 970 dual ribbon, heavy duty office machine at a government price of \$554.70 less trade-in of Royal FP-13-6456632 at \$20.00, making a total cost of \$534.70. Mr. Mathia also presented the Board a quotation from IBM Corporation for an IBM selectric typewriter at a cost of \$630.
