Solid Wate': Discussion between Jofforent ag. co. Comment outlying citie Dean Sanderson, Public Works Director, appeared before the Board with sealed quotations from three farm equipment vendors relative to his request for quotations for two tractors for which he had issued guideline specifications. After giving due consideration of the three quotations received and giving effect to all considerations which the Public Works Department felt would be essential, it was moved by Mr. Stoneback that the Board accept the quotation of Deems Farm Equipment to furnish two Model 1530 John Deere tractors at a net cost to Douglas County of \$14,220, delivery made within ten days, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried unanimously.

The Board considered Resolution No. 75-8 which resolution relates to inspections by various regulatory bodies, and standards and qualifications for certain aspects of the ambulance service. After due discussion on the resolution it was moved by Mr. Whitenight that Resolution No. 75-8 be hereby adopted, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.

The Board further discussed a request from the Douglas County Comprehensive Health Planning Council that the Board appoint four members to a committee to study the feasibility of public ownership of Cherry Manor. Following due discussion it was moved by Mr. Whitenight that the Board accede to the request of the Douglas County Comprehensive Health Planning Council for the appointment of four members to the committee, but that the Board intends not to be bound in any manner by actions or recommendations of the appointed committee, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.

At 1:30 p.m. a meeting was convened for the purpose of reviewing status of solid waste disposal discussions which have taken place between representatives of N. R. Hamm, Inc., Douglas County Commission, Jefferson County Commission, and City of Lawrence. In addition to representatives of the aforementioned the cities of Baldwin, Eudora, and Lecompton were also represented. The meeting concluded with basic understandings which are set out in a special memo which is filed under "solid waste" in the office of the Douglas County Commission.
