chip spreader*

Engineer Sanderson presented the Board with quotes for application of liquid asphalt to be applied to certain County roads and unit price per ton for the furnishing of a self-propelled chip spreader used in the operation of sealing County roads. These request for quotes had been sent out to vendors as of May 20, 1975. Three quotes were received. Following review of the quotes received, it was moved by Mr. Stoneback that the Board accept the low quote of N. R. Hamm Contractor, Inc., to apply liquid asphalt at a rate of \$0.12 per gallon and to furnish the self-propelled chip spreader at a unit price of \$0.78 per ton, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried unanimously.

The Board noted receipt of the minutes of the June 5 meeting of the CSA Board, upon which Mr. Whitenight discussed briefly with the Board the contents thereof.
