The Board noted receipt of Application No. 9 from Robertson, Peters & Williams, architects, for construction payment on the judicial and law enforcement center in the amount of \$99,353.94 for the period June 1, 1975 through June 29, 1975. Public Works Director Sanderson presented to and discussed with the Board a proposed agreement with consultants Finney & Turnipseed relative to rechecking of nineteen bridges on Douglas County FAS routes. The agreement calls for the payment of the lump sum of \$2,500 for these services to be paid within thirty days after proper billing by the consultants and acceptance by our Board of this report. Following due discussion it was moved by Mr. Whitenight that this agreement be approved, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.
