Sherlyn Sampson, Clerk of District Court, requested employment of Martha A. Harper as a temporary employee in her office with specific duties being updating of computer ledger. Giving effect to computer experience Mrs. Sampson requested a wage rate of \$2.50 per hour with employment being effective July 21, 1975. Wayne Kellum, Zoning Administrator, presented to the Board second quarter report of his office. Pub. Works: classed bridge on Dy .- Fran Co. line 1.2

The Board noted receipt of a communication from Director of Public Works Dean Sanderson advising that excessive deterioration has caused County line Bridge No. 00.00N-17.63E on the Douglas-Franklin County line to be unsafe for use and beyond repair, and that said bridge has been condemned and is now closed for traffic. Mr. Sanderson recommended that the Board of Commissioners of Franklin and Douglas County initiate joint action to replace this bridge pursuant to K.S.A. 68-1122. Following due consideration it was moved by Mr. Whitenight that we notify the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County that Douglas County is prepared to engage a consultant to perform the field survey preliminary design, and construction engineering for said bridge and the con-
