In connection with the policy of locking the gates at Wells Park at 10:00 p.m. each evening, the Board finds it necessary that proper procedure be established to be certain that the gates are unlocked each morning. Mr. Kenneth Markley, an employee of the Road and Bridge Department, has been retained on an oral agreement basis that for a sum of \$25 per month he will be responsible for unlocking the Wells Park gates each day. This agreement becoming effective September 18, 1975. It was moved by Mr. Stoneback that this agreement be approved, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried unanimously.

The Board considered Home Rule Resolution No. HR-75-9-2 which had been prepared by Counselor Young. The resolution relates to the assuming by the Board of Commissioners of the responsibility for carrying out all the provisions of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, and the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. This resolution is necessitated to allow the Board to administer properly funds received through a grant under the Community Development Act.
