The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

Comm. Order # 1447

The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 1446 and 1447. Orders are on file in the office of the County Clerk.

Pul Works: accepted quate of Cause, cone, for wood chipper Engineer Sanderson further discussed with the Board bids received for the wood chipper. It was Engineer Sanderson's recommendation that we accept the quotation of Causco, Inc. to furnish (1) Chipmore brush chipper, Model TM-160-C4 with Ford 330 V-8 cylinder, Industrial Engine, clutch drive, 16" cutter bar, and (1) extra set (4) 16" chipper blades at a cost of \$5,993.75, f.o.b. Lawrence. It was moved by Mr. Whitenight that the recommendation of Engineer Sanderson be approved, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.

Ambilance: Sald 1967 Postice and. To Emest Coleman At 10:00 a.m. the Board opened bids which were received as advertised for the 1967 Pontiac ambulance. Two bids were received. Following review of the bids and waiving by Mr. Ernest Coleman of his inclusion for the furnishing of a cot in the vehicle, it was moved by Mr. Whitenight that the Board accept the bid of Mr. Ernest Coleman which bid was in the amount of \$415, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously. The Board noted Mr. Coleman's intent was that the vehicle would be used by a licensed operator for a youth camp south of Arkansas City, Kansas.

The Board noted receipt of financial statements for the Valleyview Care Home for the period ending October 31, 1975.

Grants: new antilance arrived Ambulance Manager Ted McFarlane reported to the Board that the new ambulance unit, the bid for which was accepted on October 9, 1975, had arrived as of November 25. The Board requested Mr. McFarlane to extend an invitation to a representative of MARCER to review with him the vehicle relative to meeting specifications and the reimbursement process in connection therewith. Following this review Mr. McFarlane will be expected to make a recommendation to the Board.

Personnel; Debra Cyr on pregnency leave of absence County Assessor Darwin Rogers requested a leave of absence for reason of pregnancy for Debra Cyr, with this leave of absence to be effective December 3 with the indication that Debra Cyr at present intends to return to work on or before February 9, 1976. It was moved by Mr. Whitenight that this leave of absence be granted, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.
