The quote presented by Mr. Steele was from Kaw Valley Implement Company for one Imco rotary cutter with hookup attachments at a total price of \$1374 less \$300 trade-in for a net cost to Douglas County of \$1074. Following due discussion it was moved by Mr. Stoneback that the Board accept this quote for the aforementioned equipment, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Steele presented the Board with two quotes for two new chain saws with trade-in. Following review of the quotes it was moved by Mr. Whitenight that we accept the bid of Kuhn Truck & Tractor Company at a net cost to the County of \$285, seconded by Mr. Stoneback, and carried unanimously.
