Representatives of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company; Mr. Mike Wildgen, Assistant City Manager, City of Lawrence; Mr. Bob Green, B. A. Green Construction Company; and Mr. Stan Harris, representing Peters, Williams and Kubota, architects, were present for a meeting for the purpose of further discussion relative to procedures involved in the installation of telephone communication system in the Law Enforcement Judicial Building with which Douglas County and the City of Lawrence will be involved. Following this discussion it was moved by Mr. Whitenight that we approve contract with Southwestern Bell Telephone Company known as Plan One Contract for Customer Premise PBX Service and further approve the customer agreement for floor plan detail which is a part thereof. The contract calls for a total payment based on a fixed monthly rate of \$41,674 which cost will be shared approximately 50% by each City of Lawrence and Douglas County with the Douglas County share being funded by revenue sharing funds, seconded by Mr. Heck, and carried.
