Sheriff Johnson reported to the Board that Delease Lee had terminated as an employee in his department as of August 1, 1976.

Ted McFarlane, Douglas County Ambulance Service Manager, reported to the Board the termination of Tom Steele effective July 23, 1976, Bob Wray effec-tive August 2, 1976, Jim Fabert effective July 25, 1976, and Steve Guinn effective August 15, 1976.

Al Morris, representing Hamm Quarries, Inc., and Engineer Sanderson discussed with the Board a proposed contract with Hamm Quarries, Inc. to furnish to Douglas County approximately 30,000 tons of AB-3 base material at \$2.10 per ton stockpiled at what is known as Harrell Quarry. Following due discussion which related to competitive prices and hauling mileage it was moved by Mr. Stoneback that this proposed contract be approved, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried unanimously.

It was then moved by Mr. Stoneback that the 1977 Douglas County Budget as proposed and officially published be herewith adopted, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried unanimously.

> At the official publicized time of 10:00 a.m. for public hearing relative to maintenance budgets for the various sewer districts of Douglas County the Board further considered said budgets as proposed and officially published. No persons appeared to comment or discuss the sewer maintenance budgets. It was then moved by Mr. Stoneback that the sewer maintenance budgets be adopted as proposed and officially published, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried unanimously.

The Board noted receipt of a copy of communication from the office of the Attorney General of the State of Kansas to Dean Sanderson, Director of Public Works, which communication notifies Mr. Sanderson that the intergovernmental agreement between Douglas County and the City of Lawrence relative to use by Douglas County of the City of Lawrence Landfill had been approved by that office.
