The Board noted receipt of copy of memo from Engineer of Secondary Roads to Mr. Robert Slease, public information director of the Kansas Department of Transportation, requesting necessary legal notice to advise residents and interested parties of the project features on Douglas County road project beginning 0.6 mile east of the Osage-Douglas County line and 1.5 miles north of US-56 Highway and extending east approximately 0.2 mile. The memo indicates that Douglas County is requesting location and design approval for grading, surfacing, and seeding for a rural two-lane facility. The Board later noted receipt of notice from the Kansas Department of Transportation that legal notice relative to this hearing had been officially published.

Darlene Hill, budget director, reported to the Board that the County valuation for 1976 as of September 16, 1976, which is the valuation which will be used for taxing purposes is \$165,658,107 which is an increase of \$2,158,000 over the July 1 valuation. Mrs. Hill indicated to the Board that this new valuation figure would result in approximate County mill levy reduction of 0.30 mills, from 23.06 to 22.76.

Mr. Jack Landreth, of the firm Landreth, McGrew & Johnson representing the Lawrence Insurance Board, presented the Board premium notices of policies covering county property and vehicle liability. Policy No. SM06572930 covering county property has a premium cost of \$13,207, and Policy No. GL07400449 covering vehicle liability has a premium cost of \$4507. Mr. Landreth explained that there is a credit due to Douglas County in the amount of \$4263 resulting from cancellation of the public officials liability by Reserve Insurance Company.
