Darwin Rogers, appraiser, appeared before the Board to request a two-year merit review for two of his employees. The first being Mary Ann Chamberlain, real estate clerk, whose present salary is \$562 per month. Mr. Rogers requested that her salary be increased \$60 per month bringing her salary to \$622 per month to commence as of February 1, 1977. Secondly, he requested that the salary of Virginia Hamm, clerk, be given a two-year increase of \$51 per month bringing her salary to \$555 per month as of March 1, 1977. After discussion on these requests it was moved by Mr. Neis that they be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

Ernest Coleman, federal funds consultant, appeared before the Board to present for the Board's approval four revenue sharing contracts as follows:

Mr. Coleman presented a letter from the Rape Victims Support Service indicating their request that \$545.06 be expended from the projected revenue sharing allocation to that organization. The balance of the \$1500 allocation would be held as potential local matching monies for a GCCA grant which is currently being sought. This \$545.06 would be expended over the next three month period for office supplies, telephone, rental of office space, and contractual compensation. After discussion on this request it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this request be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Ernest Coleman, consultant for community development funds, presented the Board with three contracts for rehabilitation as follows: Project No. 214 in the amount of \$2,396 with Paslay-Smith Construction Company, Project No. 226 in the amount of \$223 with Colhun Construction Company, and Project No. 320 in the amount of \$1,182 with Colhun Construction Company. After review of these contracts it was moved by Mr. Neis that the contracts be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

Tax Appeal: app.
Exceed '77 budget
for running Valley
View - K.S.A. 79-2939

The Board noted receipt from the State Board of Tax Appeals of their order dated February 7, 1977, in the matter of the application of the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, requesting authority to exceed their budget of expenditures for the current budget year. The order indicated a number of specific findings in regard to our petition and made the following determination regarding this request:

"It is, therefore, by the State Board of Tax Appeals of the State of Kansas, considered and ordered that the applicant be, and it is hereby, authorized to exceed its budget of expenditures during the current budget year in an amount not exceeding \$341,900.00, in order to operate the Valley View Nursing Home. This relief is granted pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 79-2939."

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Thursday, February 10, 1977.
