Engineer Sanderson presented the Board prepared contracts, performance, maintenance, and statutory bonds between Douglas County and Bushman Construction Company relative to Douglas County Consolidated Project 77-1. It was moved by Mrs. Bradley that the Board approve these prepared contracts, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Weed Dept. app.
Change bidders due
to price change

Bob Duver, noxious weed supervisor, appeared before the Board to indicate a change was required in our previous determination of purchase of chemicals. Mr. Duver indicates that when the original quote from Thompson-Hayward was again brought to their attention that they indicated that the price had changed substantially and they thereby were no longer the low quote for the purchase of this chemical, thereupon Mr. Duver recommends to the Board that the purchase be made from the second low quote company, Co-op Chemical Company of Lawrence, Kansas, and that we purchase 100 gallons in (1) gallon cans at the rate of \$5.02 per gallon and 3,900 gallons in (5) gallon cans at the rate of \$4.85 per gallon which brings the total amount of the purchase to \$19,417 which is an addition of \$199 from our previous statement. After review of this recommendation it was moved by Mr. Neis that this change in vendor be accepted, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

Ernest Coleman, consultant for community development block grant funds, appeared before the Board to present six contracts for housing rehabilitation. All six contracts are between the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County and the Colhun Construction Company of Lawrence, Kansas as follows: (1) Rehab Project No. 233 for \$1035, (2) Rehab Project No. 235 for \$2367, (3) Rehab Project No. 306 for \$1545, (4) Rehab Project No. 330 for \$2255, (5) Rehab Project No. 331 for \$2479, and (6) Rehab Project No. 333 for \$675. The documentation indicates that all of these housing rehab contracts have been approved by the Penn House representative, by the grant approval committee, and by the administrator of the community development block grant funds. After review of these contracts it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that these contracts be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.
