The petition basically is seeking recovery for damages in the amount of \$165,000.00 based on the negligence of the defendants in causing damage to a Douglas County bridge which occurred on 17 April 1976. Bridge-Co. 31566B 1976 damage Do to a budge Re-Assign app. The Board noted receipt of Administrative Order No. 17 from the administrative Judge of the Seventh Judicial District of Kansas which order appoints Nancy Lignitz from Acting Director to Director of Volunteers in Court effective 1 September 1977, and further orders that the director be authorized to solicit and recommend a half-time assistant director to begin work on 1 September 197 at a salary as authorized by the Board of County Commissioners.
