At the advertised hour of 10:00 a.m., the Board opened bids for the sale of three surplus tractors with mowers from the public works department. Seven bids were received with it appearing that the high bid submitted was by Grob § Sons for \$2650 for all three tractors, however, it was moved by Mr. Neis that the bids be taken under advisement and reviewed by the public works di-rector and make a recommendation at a later time. This motion seconded by Mrs. Bradley and carried unanimously. After a brief review by Mr. Sanderson it was verified that the bid of Grob § Sons in the amount of \$2650 for the three surplus tractors was the high bid.
