Sheriff Rex Johnson appeared before the Board to recommend increases in salary for those jailer/correction officers in the sheriff department whom were hired before 15 December 1976 and who are now eligible for a one-year merit increase as follows: Betty Pringle, Bruce Banning, Kim Neis, David Brown, Harold Hunsinger, Randy Pettit, Kim Pestinger, and Jerri Wiles all of whom are pre-sently earning \$668 per month.
