The Board noted receipt from the Kansas State Board of Agriculture, Division of Water Resources, that approval of its application for a permit for a proposed channel change along the Little Wakarusa Creek, at a location in the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 19, and the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 20, both in Township 13 South, Range 21 East, Douglas County, Kansas, has been granted. The approved permit has been remitted to the public works department for their file.

Darwin Rogers, county appraiser, appeared before the Board to recommend a change in classification and increase in salary for Virginia Lomax who is chief clerk in his department and who has served Douglas County for a period of ten years. Mr. Rogers recommends that she be appointed to the position of administrative office assistant effective 1 December 1977 and that her salary be increased from \$692 per month to \$760 per month which is the beginning of the bracket for ten to fifteen years of service in the administrative office assistant classification. After review of this recommendation it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that it be approved, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried.

Sheriff Rex Johnson appeared before the Board to recommend increases in salary for those jailer/correction officers in the sheriff department whom were hired before 15 December 1976 and who are now eligible for a one-year merit increase as follows: Betty Pringle, Bruce Banning, Kim Neis, David Brown, Harold Hunsinger, Randy Pettit, Kim Pestinger, and Jerri Wiles all of whom are presently earning \$668 per month. The sheriff recommends an increase for these individuals except Hunsinger and Pettit to a new rate as of 1 December 1977 of \$709 per month. Regarding Hunsinger and Pettit the sheriff recommends, that since they are shift supervisors, that they be compensated at the level of \$721 per month commencing 1 December 1977. The sheriff also recommends a one-year merit increase for Betty Moore, jailer/correction officer who was hired 27 December 1976, presently earning \$668 per month to be increased to \$709 per month effective 1 January 1978. After a complete review of these recommendations it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that they be approved, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Thursday, December 8, 1977.
