These requests for commercial zoning were considered as a package by the planning commission and were forwarded to this Board with no recommendation on a 4-4 vote. A complete hearing was held on the merits of these commercial zoning requests and after full consideration it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that the request be taken under advisement by this Board for further review and consideration with a formal decision to be published at the hour of 10:30 a.m. on 22 February 1978. This motion seconded by Mr. Neis and carried unanimously. imously.
