Delbert Mathia, county clerk, appeared before the Board to request an increase in salary for Lois McGovern, bookkeeper in his department, based upon a merit review on the anniversary of her fifth year with Douglas County. Mr. Mathia recommends that Mrs. McGovern be increased to the top of the scale for persons in her classification for 5 to 10 years which is \$738 per month to be effective 1 February 1978. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously. imously.
