Zoning! app. Privale road for Ron Hallany Wayne Kellum, County Zoning Administrator, and Mr. Ron Haskey appeared before the Board to request approval of a recorded private easement as an approved private way for the purpose of securing a building permit to construct a house in Palmyra Township in Douglas County.
