Fremont Hornberger, maintenance supervisor, appeared before the Board to pre-sent quotes as follows: (1) On a project to provide covering in the land-ings and steps on the front steps to the lower level in the judicial and law enforcement center. Two quotes were presented, one from K & M Decorating the back of \$24 and one from Parsons & Kring in the amount of \$595.65. (2) At the fairgrounds in the restrooms between Building 1 and 2 and the hallway adjoining them to install Armstrong Brigantine vinyl covering and new top set base in the areas described from K & M Decorating Center in the amount of \$560.05 and from Parsons & Kring a quote of \$580.00. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that the low quote for these two pro-jects be accepted as follows: For the judicial and law enforcement center the quote from Parsons & Kring in the amount of \$595.65 to be paid from the maintenance budget and for the fairgrounds the low quote of K & M Decorating Center in the amount of \$560.05 to be paid from the fair fund, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Hornberger then presented to the Board two quotes for providing electri-cal service for an air conditioner which it is desired to have installed in the kitchen service area for the jail. The two quotes are from Norris Bros. Inc. in the amount of \$129 and from Huxtable & Associates, Inc. in the amount of \$157. After review it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that the low quote of Norris Bros. Inc. be accepted, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Judy Osburn, director of court services, appeared before the Board to recom-mend the approval of the final submission of a grant to GCCA entitled "Doug-las County Court Services Project", which relates to the position currently held by Mr. Gerald Barrix as a court services counselor. The duration of this grant, if approved, will be from 1 July 1978 to 30 June 1979 and the application projects a net cost of \$13,724 with a contribution from the fed-eral government thru GCCA in the amount of \$4,050.01, the state contribution will be \$225, with the contribution to be made by Douglas County in the a-mount of \$9,448.99. After complete discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this grant application be approved for submission to GCCA, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.
