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Beginning at a point 28.92 feet south and 40.0 feet west of the northwest corner of Lot 136, Block 42, West Lawrence, and Addition to the City of Law-rence, Kansas, thence westerly 40.0 feet, to a point 22.0 feet south of the northeast corner of Lot 135, Block 43, in said addition, said point being the termination of the line.

(d) An easement for a 10 inch sanitary sewer 5.0 feet either side of the following described line:

Beginning at a point 67.51 feet north and 33.04 feet west of the northwest corner of Lot 136, Block 42, West Lawrence, an Addition to the City of Lawrence, Kansas, thence northwesterly 47.5 feet, to a point 72.67 feet west and 90.05 feet north of the northwest corner of said Lot 136, thence west 7.0 feet, to the termination of the line.

(e) An easement for an 8 inch sanitary sewer 5.0 feet either side of the following described line:

Beginning at a point 33.04 feet west and 67.51 feet north of the northwest corner of Lot 136, Block 42, West Lawrence, an Addition to the City of Lawrence, Kansas, thence northerly 90.0 feet, to a point 150.21 feet north and 35.0 feet west of the northwest corner of said Lot 136, said point being the termination of the line.

(f) An easement for an 8 inch sanitary sewer 5.0 feet either side of the following described line:

Beginning at a point 33.04 feet west and 67.51 feet North of the northwest corner of Lot 136, Block 42, West Lawrence, an Addition to the City of Law-rence, Kansas, thence easterly 35.0 feet, to a point 72.0 feet north of the northwest corner of said Lot 136, said point being the termination of the the line.

(g) An easement for a 16 inch water line 5.0 feet either side of the follow-ing described line:

Beginning at a point 12.0 feet west of the northwest corner of Lot 130, Block 42, West Lawrence, an Addition to the City of Lawrence, Kansas, thence south 382.13 feet, to a point 15.0 feet west and 16.5 feet north of the southwest corner of Lot 79, Block 42, in said Addition, thence southwesterly 17.5 feet, to a point 7.5 feet north and 31.0 feet west of the southwest corner of said Lot 79, thence south 7.5 feet, to the termination of the line.

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The Board considered the appointment of an appraiser for Douglas County to fill the position which is being vacated by Darwin Rogers. Over a period of several weeks the Board has notified all eligible Kansas candidates, has accepted and re-viewed ten applications, and has interviewed seven of these individuals.
