The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with two members of the Board present. Beverly Bradley was absent due to surgery.

Fremont Hornberger, maintenance supervisor, appeared before the Board to recommend an increase in salary for Darrell Abel effective 1 June 1978 which is the one year anniversary of his employment with Douglas County. Mr. Hornberger recommends a 6% increased based upon Mr. Abel's excellent work for Douglas County which would raise his salary from \$735 per month to \$779 per month. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried.

Transfer -Margie Thomton

Sheriff Johnson appeared before the Board and requested the transfer of Margie Thornton from the emergency preparedness office to the position of corrections officer in the Sheriff's office effective 1 June 1978. Ms. Thornton would be transferring from a half-time position to a full-time position and the salary assigned will be \$670 per month. After review with Travis Brann, emergency preparedness coordinator, to secure his concurrence in this transfer, it was moved by Mr. Neis that the Sheriff's request be approved, seconded by Mr. Whitenight, and carried. It was agreed with Mr. Brann that he might use Ms. Thornton on a limited time basis in his office until a replacement can be found to assist him with necessary budget preparations and other reports needed in his office. It was agreed that such work as he assigns on this part-time basis will be paid at an overtime rate based upon her halftime salary as it existed in the EP office.
