it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that the Board make the following findings with regard to the release of lands from Rural Water District No. 2:

- That a majority of the members of the Board of Directors of Rural Water District No. 2, Douglas County, Kansas, do not object to such statement, and endorse the action prayed for in the petition.

- That publication of the notice of this hearing was had in the Lawrence Journal-World on 21 July 1978, the same being more than seven (7) days before the date fixed for this hearing, and further, that a copy of said petition and notice of this hearing was transmitted to the Chief Engineer, Division of Water Resources, State Board of Agriculture, and to each member of the Board of Directors of Rural Water District No. 5, Douglas County, Kansas, all as provided by K.S.A. 82a-615 and K.S.A. 82a-623. that a

Having so found it is hereby ordered and certified that the above described lands be released from Rural Water District No. 2 and hereby ordered and certified that the above described lands be attached to Rural Water District No. 5, Douglas County, Kansas. Motion seconded by Mr. Neis and carried unanimously.

Jack Landreth, representative of the Lawrence Insurance Board, appeared before the Board to present for final approval a statement of values which has
