The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 78 to the Sheriff, Comm. Order Clerk of District Court, and Treasurer.

Personnel: Jalanc. Sheriff Johnson appeared before the Board to recommend the approval of a ten-log year salary increase for merit for Charlotte Heiserman who serves as a radio Charlotte Meiserman dispatcher/photographer in the sheriff's department. The sheriff recommends an increase from \$828 to \$875 per month effective September 2, 1978. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Under the period, the following personnel actions shall be made: Cathym Since Kanad (1) Marjorie J. Raess, who is assigned as a basic language teacher to John Johns for USD #497, will be dropped from the CETA rolls of Douglas County as of Septem-Judy Mohn Grade ber 15, 1978.

(2) Willie L. Phelps, who is a maintenance helper in the Douglas County maintenance department, will be temporarily transferred to the regular Doug-las County payroll effective September 15, 1978.

(3) Cathy L. McGinnis, who is a health clerk/receptionist for the pub-lic health department, will be dropped from the CETA rolls of Douglas County effective September 15, 1978 and her position is to be assumed from another source of funding within the public health department.

(4) John E. Gobetz, grounds maintenance in the Douglas County noxious weed department, will be dropped from CETA funding effective September 15, 1978 and will be temporarily funded with regular Douglas County payroll ef-fective September 15, 1978.

(5) Judy M. Mohr, an activity assistant at the Douglas County Valley-view Care Home, will be dropped from the CETA rolls effective September 15, 1978 and temporarily absorbed in the Douglas County payroll effective Septem-ber 15, 1978.

It is the Board's intention that those individuals placed temporarily into the regular county payroll system will be subject to review for reinstatement into CETA or for establishment as a permanent employee of Douglas County at a later time when appropriate.
