Director of Public Works Mike Dooley appeared before the Board to present a series of recommendations:

Hopper spreaders

(1) That the Board authorize the publication of a notice to bidders that sealed bids for the purchase of three new "slide in" type hopper spreaders will be accepted by the Douglas County Public Works Department and will be received at the Office of the Director of Public Works, until 10:15 a.m., C.D.T., on October 2, 1978, and then publicly opened in the Office of the Douglas County Board of Commissioners. It is recommended that this notice be published on September 20 and 27, 1978 in the county newspaper of record. After discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Channel improvement

(2) That the Board forward to the State Board of Agriculture, Division of Water Resources, an application to make a channel improvement at the construction site of Douglas County Bridge No. 10.90N-16.45E, otherwise known as the Coal Creek Bridge. This application is accompanied by an agreement amongst the adjoining property owners which state that there are no objections to the channel change. The purpose of this channel change is to improve the channel course at the construction site. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this application be forwarded to the State Board of Agriculture, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried unanimously.

Utility agreement  
with Sec. Trans.

(3) That the Board execute a utility agreement between the Board of Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, the Secretary of Transportation, and Kansas Public Service Company, Inc., for Project 23 AHL 1593(2). The alteration of this utility is in the general location of Section 11, T13S, R19E between Highway Stations 174 and 179, as shown on the plans of this project. The description of the work is to remove and relay approximately 275 lineal feet of 4-inch steel gas line and appurtenances thereto to provide clearance for the proposed highway construction, and to salvage approximately 275 lineal feet of existing gas line. The work is to be performed by the company forces in the amount of \$5,524, of which 100% of the cost is to be borne by the county. There is a special provision which indicates that all backfill within the highway right of way limits is to be compacted to a density equal to or greater than the density of the surrounding soil. After complete discussion it was moved by Mrs. Bradley that this utility agreement be executed and forwarded to the Secretary of Transportation for his approval, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

(4) That the Board should approve D.O.T. Form No. 1303 (Special) which relates to Project 23 AHL 1593(2) and is titled "Right of Way Clearances - Utility Arrangements - Authority and Method Procedure". By this document the Board certifies as follows:

That all right of way and easements for borrow pits, channel changes and/or other construction as indicated on the plans as necessary for the construction of the said project have been acquired by the County in accordance with the provisions of the agreement above mentioned, and that any companies owning or operating utilities or other facilities within the limits of the right of way, as indicated on the plans for said project, have been contacted and arrangements made or are
