(2) Mr. Dooley presented to the Board a corrected copy from the Kansas Department of Transportation of Authority to Award Contract Commitment of County Funds on Project No. 23 RS 1347 (7), known as Kanwaka Corner - Stull Road. The corrected copy indicates that the low bid received from Frisbie Bridge Co., Inc., Topeka, Kansas, for Bridge Sta. 367+30 should be in the amount of \$121,296 instead of \$121,196. This incorrect amount was reported in the Board of County Commissioners minutes of January 4, 1979. The local share of \$183,926 will remain the same as originally reported.

(3) Mr. Dooley presented an application for Authority to Construct buried telephone cable along a county road at a point approximately 2640 feet west of the northeast corner of Section 32, Township 13S, Range 19E, and running west through Douglas County. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this application for Authority to Construct be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

(4) Mr. Dooley then presented a revised agreement between the Kansas Public Service Company and the Board of County Commissioners regarding adjustment of utilities on Clinton Parkway Project 23 AHL 1593 (2). This revised agreement was executed because the original agreement dated September 6, 1978, contained statements which were not approved by the Kansas Department of Transportation Legal Department. This revised agreement has been approved by the Kansas Department of Transportation Legal Department and contains additional hold harmless clauses which were necessary to satisfy legal interpretations. Also, the original agreement provided for the signature of only one county commissioner and this agreement requires the signature of all three county commissioners. There is no change in the terms of the agreement or the estimated total cost of the work to be accomplished which is \$5,524. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that the revised agreement be executed and returned to the Kansas Department of Transportation, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Thursday, January 18, 1979.
