Mike Malone, district attorney, appeared before the Board to recommend the acceptance of a federal grant for approximately \$29,000 from the Law Enforcement Assistance Agency (LEAA) to start a program to identify habitual criminals. Mr. Malone stated that the county would have to pay about 10 percent of the cost of the grant. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this grant be approved with the understanding that it will be reviewed in December 1979, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Bob Steele, Douglas County Parks Supervisor, appeared before the Board to recommend merit increases for employees in his department as follows:

(1) Ronald Guthrie, an increase of \$17 per month, bringing his salary from \$716 to \$733 per month.

(2) Charles Nichols, an increase of \$17 per month, bringing his salary from \$716 to \$733 per month.

After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that these increases be approved as of January 6, 1979, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board to request the employment of Darrel V. Davis as a common laborer at the rate of \$649 per month, effective February 12, 1979. This employee will be a CETA Title VI. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this request be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Dooley then requested approval for authorization of expenditures for up to \$2,000 to Deems Farm Equipment to overhaul a diesel engine. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that this request be approved, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

Fremont Hornberger, maintenance supervisor, appeared before the Board to request approval of the purchase of 27 window shades; cloth, vinyl coated, room darkening, insulated, plus hardware, to be used in Buildings #1 and #2 at the Douglas County Fairgrounds. Four bids were received as follows: K-Mart \$206.31, Gibson's \$325.71, Montgomery Wards \$410.70 and Jan's Interior \$517.40. After complete discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis to award the bid to Montgomery Wards even though it was not the low bid, it was the best quality, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Positions will be  
all year full time  
with money help  
from Corps of Eng.*

Rex Johnson, Sheriff, appeared before the Board to request the approval of three additional positions to provide law enforcement surveillance at Clinton Lake for a 6-month period from 1 April to 30 September 1979. The amount of \$37,200 was negotiated with the Corps of Engineers and was arrived at and agreed to as follows:

Labor: 120 days x 18 hours/day = 2160 hours  
2160 hours x \$12.20/hour = \$26,352

Vehicle Rental: 6 months x \$800/month = \$4,800

Vehicle Operation: 200 miles/day x 120 days = 24,000 miles  
24,000 miles x \$.18/mile = \$4,320

Miscellaneous Equipment Rental: \$200/month x 6 months = \$1,200

Mobilization and Orientation: one time charge = \$500

Total: \$37,172, Say \$37,200

This amount is to be provided to us by the Corps of Engineers and these funds would be used to employ three additional deputies for the period of 1979. After complete discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that we accept this contract in the amount of \$37,200 for the purpose of employing additional deputies to provide law enforcement surveillance at Clinton Lake, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.
