County Well: app.
Raise rates on
price of water

Mr. & Mrs. Hyluard B. Maichel, Route 2, Overbrook, Kansas, appeared before the Board concerning the usage of well water from the county well on their property located in the North $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 14 South, Range 17 East, in Douglas County, Kansas. Mr. & Mrs. Maichel request that paragraph 3 of the contract agreement dated January 23, 1970, between the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, first party, and Hyluard B. Maichel, second party, be amended to read as follows:

3. Second party may furnish and install a water meter; and shall have the right to charge a well operation fee to the public at the rate of twenty-five cents per one hundred fifty gallons.

This change would increase the well operation fee to the public to the rate of twenty-five cents per one hundred fifty gallons from the present rate of ten cents per one hundred gallons. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Cragan that a new contract agreement be drawn up increasing the rate to twenty-five cents per one hundred fifty gallons, seconded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Monday, March 26, 1979.
