The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with all members of the Board present.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of April 18, 1979.

Personnel: Term District Attorney Mike Malone notified the Board that Debra K. Snyder will terminate on April 30, 1979.

Employ Mr. Malone appeared before the Board to recommend hiring for the Career Criminal Program Grant as follows:

W. St. Laurent
J. Roberts (1) Wanda E. St. Laurent, to fill the position of part-time secretary, at a salary of \$350 per month, effective April 19, 1979.

(2) Janet E. Roberts, to fill the position of Program Coordinator, at a salary of \$1083.33 monthly, effective May 1, 1979.

After review of these recommendations it was moved by Mr. Neis that they be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously. This CCP Grant is scheduled to terminate December 31, 1979, but may be renewed at that time depending upon performance of the grant.

Data Process: app. Jim Tate, data processing coordinator, appeared before the Board with two quotes for a photocopy machine cabinet #H20-2020. Mr. Tate recommended the purchase of the low quote of Strong's Office Systems at a total price of \$122.36. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that the low quote be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Kaw River Bridge
Deny request for
trash guard Mr. Stephen H. Hill, of The Bowersock Mills & Power Company, appeared before the Board to request permission to install a 16 foot long 4-inch I-Beam to the side of the southernmost bridge pier of the new Massachusetts Street Bridge in order to attach a trash guard. This proposed trash guard is to be used for The Bowersock Mills & Power Company power plant intake located on the dam and just below the new Kansas River Bridge being constructed by Anderson Construction Company. The purpose of this trash guard is to prevent logs and other floating debris from clogging the headgates at the entrance to the power plant flume. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis and seconded by Mr. Cragan that the Board deny Mr. Hill's second request to attach a trash guard to the new Massachusetts Street Bridge over the Kaw River on the basis of further review of the file from Mr. Mike Doolley's office, public works director, and conversation with Mr. Dan Young, county counselor. Motion carried unanimously.

No further business, the Board adjourned to meet on Monday, April 23, 1979.

Personnel: Employ Jim Tate, data processing coordinator, appeared before the Board to recommend the employment of Cynthia L. Farmer in the position of key entry operator, at a starting salary of \$520 per month, effective April 24, 1979. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Term Sheriff Rex Johnson notified the Board that Troy Anderson will terminate on May 11, 1979.

Trans Sheriff Johnson also notified the Board that Jerri Baldwin has been transferred from jailer/corrections officer at the rate of \$850 per month to shift supervisor at the rate of \$859 per month, effective April 14, 1979. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this transfer be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Extension Council
1980 budget
approved The Board met with members of the Douglas County Extension Council, represented by Dorothy Congrove, chairman, and with Mr. Richard F. King, who is representing the Director of Extension at Kansas State University, to discuss the budget for the Extension Council for the period January 1, 1980 to December 31, 1980. After a complete review of the budget as it was presented, which totaled \$190,726 and which included an appropriation of the Douglas County tax funds of \$138,671.78 and reflects a 7% increase, it was moved by Mr. Cragan that the budget be adopted and that the county budget appropriations be so set. Motion seconded by Mr. Neis and carried unanimously by all five members of the group voting in accordance with the terms of K.S.A. 2-610 as amended.
