West of the South Quarter Corner of Section 27, Township 12 South, Range 18 East, in Douglas County, Kansas, said point being on the center line of Fed-eral Aid Secondary Route 212; thence East on said center line to said Quar-ter Corner, as set by K.S.A. 8-1560, is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist on the above described county road or highway under the jurisdiction of this Board. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that the Board adopt Resolution No. 79-24 establishing a speed limit of 40 miles per hour on the above described county road or highway, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.
