Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board with Resolution No. 79-31. This resolution establishes a twelve ton gross weight limit on Bridge No. 14.55N-21.70E on County Road No. 1061. Based upon an engineering and traffic investigation, this load resolution is necessitated due to the severe deterioration of the bridge deck. This action was taken in accordance with K.S.A. 8-1912 and shall become effective when appropriate signs are erected. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this resolution be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried.
