The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in regular adjourned session with two members of the Board present. Mr. Cragan was absent due to illness.

Approved the minutes of the meeting of December 20, 1979.

The Board approved Commissioners Cancellation Order No. 1913 and 1914. Orders are on file in the office of the County Clerk.

The Board considered Resolution No. 79-44 which resolution relates to granting a cereal malt beverage license to Robert Hughes for use at Country Corner, Route 1, Lawrence, Kansas. It was moved by Mr. Neis that this resolution be adopted, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried.

Bob Duver, Douglas County noxious weed director, appeared before the Board with three quotes for 540 gallons of 2,4-D; Formula 40. This chemical will be used for roadsides in 1980. Mr. Duver recommended that the Board accept the low quote from Mid States Ag. Chem. in the amount of \$5,022. After review of the quotes it was moved by Mr. Neis that this recommendation be approved, seconded by Mrs. Bradley, and carried.
