Kathy Smith, Valleyview Administrator, and the Community Advisory Board have recommended the following rate increases for Valleyview Care Home effective March 1, 1980:

Private Room:	\$690 per month (\$60 per month increase)
4-bed wards:	\$575 per month (\$25 per month increase)
2-bed wards:	\$640 per month (\$50 per month increase)
