(1) In the matter of the vacation of a portion of a utility easement for a sixteen (16) inch waterline, situated in Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas, being five (5) feet either side of the following described line, to-wit: Beginning at a point 12.0 feet west of the northwest corner of Lot 130, Block 42, West Lawrence, an Addition to the City of Lawrence, Kansas, thence south 382.13 feet, to a point 15.0 feet west and 16.5 feet north of the southwest corner of Lot 79, Block 42, in said Addition, thence southwesterly 17.5 feet, to a point 7.5 feet north and 31.0 feet west of the southwest corner of said Lot 79, thence south 7.5 feet, to the termination of the line.

(2) In the matter of the vacation of that portion of Pennsylvania Street beginning at the North Right-of-Way line of 8th Street, and extending North to the South Right-of-Way line of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad, in the original Townsite, City of Lawrence, Douglas County, Kansas.
