Bettion: app. The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County note that there has been submitted to the Board a petition signed by over 5% of the qualified elec-tors of the county requesting the county commissioners submit to the electors of the county at the next primary or general election, a proposition which ball be placed on the ballot in substantially the following form: "Shall Douglas County eliminate the tax on intangible personal property and be authorized to impose and levy property taxes or any other taxes as may be authorized by law or to levy taxes on real estate and tangible personal pro-perty in addition to any aggregate levy amount limitation on the county's ad valorem tax levy authority as may be necessary to offset the revenue lost from elimination of the tax on intangible personal property?" The submission of the petition in compliance with K.S.A. 79-3109 requires the county to sub-mit the question to the electors. The Board has been advised by the County Election Officer that the question will be on the ballot in compliance with the requirements of K.S.A. 79-3109. The question will be submitted at the primary election to be held on August 5, 1980.

Don Gordon, county appraiser, notified the Board that the total assessed valuation for Douglas County on real estate is \$115,806,780, which represents an increase of \$4,723,570. The personal property assessed valuation is \$30,187,955. Mr. Gordon stated that it is not possible to show an increase or decrease in personal property since most motor vehicles have been removed from the personal property rolls by law.

The Board noted receipt of Permit from the Kansas State Board of Agriculture, Division of Water Resources, granting approval of plans relating to the con-struction of a three span (33'-44'-33') bridge and a channel change along Little Wakarusa Creek, at a location in the SE% of Section 18 and the NE% of Section 19, Township 13 South, Range 21 East, Douglas County, Kansas, for Bridge No. 11.95N-20.70E. The approved Permit has been remitted to the pub-lic works department for their file.
