At the advertised hour of 10:00 a.m., the Board opened sealed bids to sell a At the advertised nour of 10:00 a.m., the board opened seared bus to sell a 1970 Model Kodak micro-star reader from the Register of Deeds Office. Only one bid was received, from Osage County Commissioners Office, Osage County, Kansas, in the amount of \$350.00. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this bid be accepted, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

The Board adjourned at 10:30 a.m. to go on a tour of Douglas County roads with Mike Dooley, public works director. The Board resumed regular session at 1:30 p.m.

Mike Dooley, public works director, appeared before the Board with a bid from the Victor L. Phillips Co., for the purchase of One Good Road Hopper Spreader in the amount of \$3,896.00 to be used by the Public Works Department. This bid was recommended for acceptance based on the fact that Douglas County currently owns and operates three spreaders of this make. It was recommended that all Hopper Spreaders should be of the same make in order to simplify maintenance and operation procedures as well as reduce necessary parts inven-tories. Mr. Dooley then presented an agreement for the Board to sign authorizing The World Company to construct and install aerial cable along county roads 6-A, 81, 17, 374 and 593 in Wakarusa and Eudora Townships. This action was taken after this installation had been formally approved by the Eudora and Wakarusa Township Boards. Mr. Cragan moved that the Board sign this agreement, sec-onded by Mr. Neis, and carried unanimously.
