Agree SW Bell Tele on Proj 80-1

Mr. Dooley then presented the Board an Agreement between Southwestern Bell Telephone Company and Douglas County for Project 80-1 (Twin Mound Construction). Douglas County intends to improve a portion of FAS Route 1249 and 1273 described as follows: Beginning 1140.5 ft. N. of the 1/4 corner on the W. line of Section 6, Township 14S, Range 18E, thence S. to said 1/4 corner on the West line of Section 6, thence W. 1 mile to the 1/4 corner on the W. line of Section 13, Township 14S, Range 17E, thence S. 1 1/4 miles to the N.W. corner of Section 14, Township 14S, Range 17E and terminating at said point. Southwestern Bell will maintain, adjust or construct its facilities which are to occupy highway right-of-way as shown by plans for the above numbered project, and no charges are involved. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that this Agreement be approved, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously.

Mr. Dooley then recommended to the Board that we publish an Advertisement for Bid for the Construction of Control Outlet Facilities Rehabilitation for Lone Star Lake. Discuss landfill

At 11:04 a.m. it was moved by Mr. Neis and seconded by Mr. Cragan that the Board adjourn to go into executive session with Counselor Dan Young and Mike Dooley, public works director, to discuss the landfill agreement. Motion carried. The Board resumed regular session at 11:22 a.m.

Solid Waste:
Agree for landfill

Mr. Dooley then presented the Board an Agreement between N. R. Hamm Quarry, Inc., the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, and the City of Lawrence. The County has complied with the State of Kansas Solid Waste Management Act of 1970, K.S.A. 65-3401 to K.S.A. 65-3417. In carrying out its responsibilities Douglas County may enter into an agreement for disposal of solid waste which fulfills its responsibilities under Kansas law. Pursuant to the Solid Waste Management Act passed by the Kansas Legislature, N. R. Hamm Quarry, Inc., and Douglas County wish to enter into an agreement that Douglas County may use the facilities of N. R. Hamm Quarry, Inc., Sanitary Landfill to fulfill Douglas County's obligation to provide for the disposal of solid waste, said landfill being located in Jefferson County, Kansas. After discussion it was moved by Mr. Neis that the Board approve this Agreement, seconded by Mr. Cragan, and carried unanimously. It should be noted that this agreement has been signed by Norman R. Hamm for N. R. Hamm Quarry, Inc., and it will now be sent to the City of Lawrence for their signatures.
